**2026/2027 Academic Year First Semester Textbook Ordering Notification
(For New Graduate Students)**

Welcome to Macau University of Science and Technology! To facilitate your study preparations, we are now starting the textbook ordering process for new graduate students. Students in need can purchase textbooks through the "MUSTbooks" function in the [WeMust Student APP](#). All textbooks are designated by the relevant Schools/faculties or lecturers, and the library only assists in providing the ordering service.

I. Ordering Period

From 00:00 on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, to 23:59 on Tuesday, June 2, 2026. Both physical and e-textbooks are available.

II. Ordering and Payment method:

1. Log in to [WeMust Student APP "MUSTbooks"](#)
2. Select required textbooks and complete payment via [WeMust](#).

III. Ordering Process

1. Download and install the latest version of the [WeMust Student APP](#).
2. Log in with your account and password, which can be found in the "Student Account" section of the online registration system.
3. After logging in, click "MUSTbooks" → "Orders" to view the automatically generated textbook orders for the next semester's subjects. You can modify this order as needed (e.g., cancel, switch to an electronic version, or add reference books).

5. Once the order is confirmed to be correct, complete the payment to ensure the order is valid.

I. Collection Time and Place

Printed Textbooks: During on-site registration at 3rd floor of Building N

E-textbooks: Access codes will be available before course commencement via:

[WeMust Student APP "MUSTbooks"](#) → "Collection" → "E-books" (for access codes and instructions).

II. Important Notes

1. Orders that have not been paid for within the ordering period can be modified at any time; paid orders cannot be modified or exchanged, and fees are non-refundable.
2. Delivery of textbooks may be delayed due to publisher stock shortages, transportation, or weather issues, and we cannot guarantee that students will receive all textbooks before the start of the semester.
3. If the amount paid changes due to faculty changing textbooks or publishers adjusting prices, the difference will be notified through the [WeMust Student APP "MUSTbooks"](#) or return to the [WeMust Wallet](#) after collection period.
4. Textbook distribution will proceed in the order of payment received.
5. Late collection of printed textbooks will incur storage fees.

III. Special Reminder

1. Please order your textbooks through the Macau University of Science and Technology Library within the designated period, and avoid purchasing textbooks through unofficial channels to prevent quality or usability issues. Several publishers have reported that some students purchased access codes or e-textbooks through unofficial channels, resulting in problems such as temporary invalidation of login passwords or assignments being erased. Publishers strongly condemn such practices and urge students not to purchase textbooks through unofficial channels; otherwise, students shall bear all associated risks and consequences.
2. Library Textbook Services is provided by the library on behalf of students to place orders with publishers or booksellers. Due to the no-return policy imposed by publishers, ordered textbooks cannot be returned or refunded under any circumstances. Students are kindly advised to consider carefully before placing an order.
3. In accordance with intellectual property protection agreements, the carrying, sale, and use of unauthorized (pirated) textbooks within Macau are strictly prohibited.
